

## DETAILED DRESS CODE PAGE 2

Please first see reverse of this card for general code.  
(Ladies must wear equivalent standard formal golf attire)

### ACCEPTABLE



Headgear must be worn correctly—not back to front

### NOT ACCEPTABLE



#### Shirts

Men's shirts must have collars and sleeves and should be worn inside trousers or shorts unless local rules apply

#### Shorts

Shorts must be tailored and cut at or just above the knee

#### Socks

Knee- or ankle-length socks are preferred

#### Shoes

Spiked, moulded or pimple-based shoes must be worn



#### Shirts

No T-shirts; football, rugby, or similar, and unless local rules apply in hot weather, shirts must not be worn outside shorts or trousers

#### Shorts

No boxer shorts; beach shorts; denim shorts or jeans

#### Socks

No trousers tucked into socks; long socks rolled down

#### Shoes

No street, canvas or sandal-type

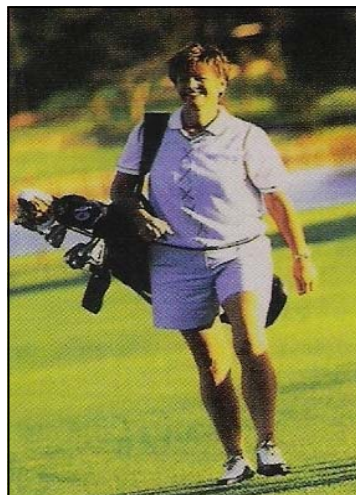
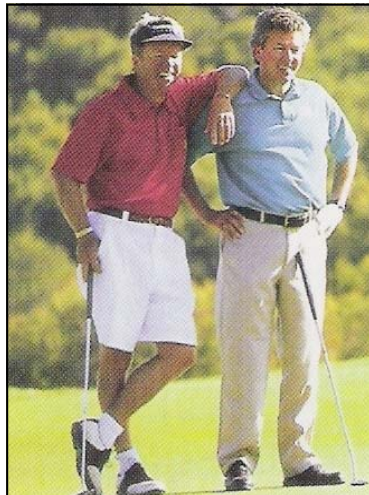
**If you are not properly dressed on your first visit to EPGC you may be allowed to play, but will be required to conform to our standard on future visits.**



## GENERAL DRESS CODE PAGE 1

All members, visitors and guests are required to wear acceptable golf attire while on the course or in its surrounds.

Clothes must be worn in a proper manner as detailed overleaf.



**Standards required for the patio and spike bar are no less than those for the course.**

Acceptable dress standards are illustrated above, and detailed overleaf.

The following are NOT permitted: T-shirts; shirts without collars; shirts cut above waist level; street shoes or sandals; beach, boxer or elasticated shorts; jeans; tracksuits or similar; trousers tucked into socks; denim; caps back to front; any other form of dress deemed to be inappropriate. NB: No caps or men's hats inside the clubhouse.
